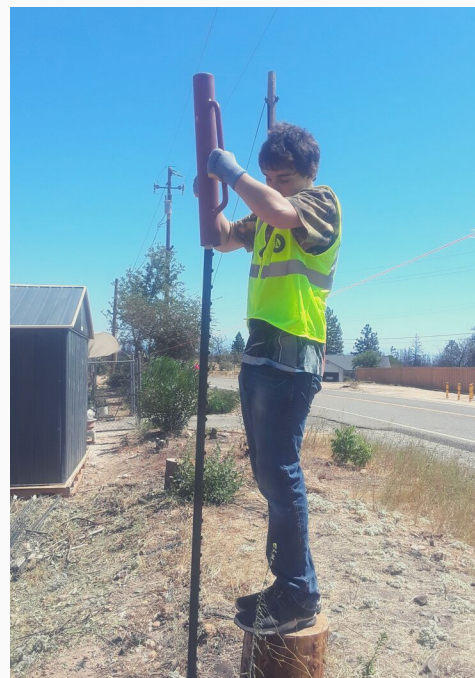


## Carr Fire Recovery
